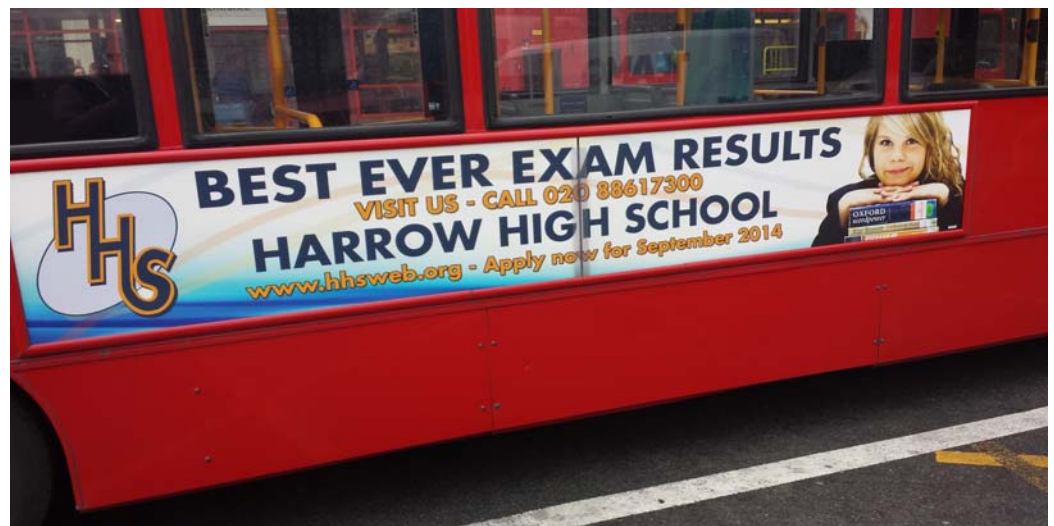

THE TEMPEST – ENGLISH DEPARTMENT

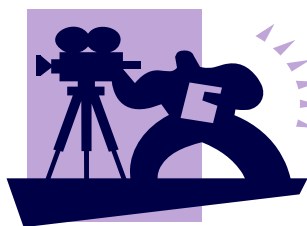
