Who is the course for?

For those individuals who have an interest and aptitude in Art and Design and who may wish to gain employment in a related field or study the subject further at Art College/University.

What can it lead to?

The A-level course is recognized by most universities as an academic subject which can be used to gain access to Art specific degrees or to supplement other A-level subjects in application for non-art degrees.

What are the entry requirements?

Completion of Study at GCSE and AS.

Interview with portfolio by Head of Department.

What will I Study?

Students explore and experiment with a range of materials and techniques including painting, drawing, 3-D sculpture as well as contextual studies.

How will I be taught?

A wide range of teaching and learning styles will be used including practicals discussion work, self-evaluation, theory and research and self motivated study.

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed through an extensive unit of course work and an externally set assignment (Exam)

Coursework =50% of AS / 25% of A level

Exam = 50% of AS / 25% of A level

What equipment or materials will I need?

Although most specialist equipment will be supplied by the Art Department learners are expected to have some basic materials. Set of Pencils and a sketchbook of cartridge paper (min. A3)
